WHITE WINES

Petritis (Xinisteri) €24.00

Brilliant light straw yellow color with sparkling slow tears. Mineral nose with juicy fresh white fruit and crunchy freshly picked nuts, evolving into ripe white plums and citrus fruit. Characterful texture with crispy fresh acidity, mouth-filling with returning minerality in the retro and medium aftertaste

Ktima Papaioannoy (Xinisteri) €24.00

Single vineyard dry white wine with a smooth texture and crisp acidity. Floral aroma and zest of citrus.

Samaropetra Kir - Yianni (Sauvignon Blanc) €31.00

Bright yellow colour, intense green aromas of freshly-cut grass and kiwi, lower alcohol and a vividly refreshing character.

Orinos Ilios Semeli (Moschofilero – Sauvignon Blanc) €25.00

Combine two highly aromatic varieties of the Peloponnesion vineyards the elegant Moschofilero with intense aroma of rose and lemon blossom and the popular Sauvignon Blanc, with citrus and exotic fruits in the foreground.

Santi - Sortesele Pinot Grigio Valdadige Doc €25.00

Straw yellow hue, accompanied by a close-focused nose of pear, apricot and white flowers. The fruity palate, with top notes of stone fruit, shows ripeness and roundness well supported by an elegant acidity and savouriness, ensuring a long, lingering finish.

Aes Ambelis - (Morokanella) €29.00

A rich and complex wine, offering a refreshing, balanced mix of fruity aromas and flavors, such as white peach, quince, wild flowers and cinnamon, leading to a pleasant aftertaste.

SPARKLING WINES

Bolla (Prosecco) €25.00

Appealing ripe fruit on the nose with hints of apple, pear, and peach. This wine is fresh and fruity on the palate with a great vein of acidity and lively finish.

Malvasia Di Castelnuovo Don Bosco (Marchesi Di Barolo) €29.00

A sparkling rose wine made exclusively from carefully picked Malvasia di Schierano grapes. The perlage is fine and persistent. The colour is pale pink, almost cherry. The aromatic pallet is intense and musky reminiscent of clear scents of wild berries, blueberries and wild strawberries. The flavour is sweet, slightly sparkling and it ignites the olfactory sensations.

Moscato D' Asti Docg Zagara (Marchesi Di Barolo) €29.00

Perlage is fine and abundant, while the color is straw-yellow with golden reflections. The aroma is intense, rich in aromatic scents – in particular, it reminds to the orange blossom, peach and apricot – in perfect balance with the low alcohol percentage and the acidity, never very high, which gives the product a pleasant freshness.

ROSE WINES

Akti – Kyperounda €28.00

A new rose wine was created through the careful selection of two grape varieties, the successful combination of which resulted in a fresh, pleasant wine.

Domaine Costa Lazaride (Merlot) €30.00

Inteus nose with notes of strawberry and lemon. Light and refreshing with a soft and round mouth and a balanced finish with hints of spices.

Le Esprit Du Lac (Xinomauro) €30.00

It captures the dynamic spirit of Xinomavro into an elegant, refreshing rose. This seasonal wine has a light body, fresh acidity and peach and strawberry aromas.

RED WINES

Geroklima (Maratheftiko) €36.00

Its deep crimson colour is accompanied by a bouquet of aromas reminiscent of red forest fruit, such as wild sour cherry and wild cherry. Balanced on the palate, it has spicy notes of freshly ground pepper and rare spices, enchanting every demanding palate.

Gerovasiliou (Syrah-Merlot) €30.00

Bright ruby red with a complex bouquet of spices and ripe dark fruits. On the palate the wine offers gentle tannins enhanced with an abundance of fruit intensity, creating the impression of strength and balance.

Ktima Avantis (Syrah) €25.00

Deep ruby colour, with complex developing bouquet. Spices pepper, cinnamon and tobacco aromas, strong sense of black fruit taste (prunes, raspberries, blackberries) jam backed fruit nuances of vanilla full body main spicy with decent ripe fine-grained tannins and long finish.

Zambartas Giannoudi €27.00

The Mediterranean variety Mattaro and the indigenous variety Yiannoudi are very well acclimatized to Cyprus warm summers and together produced an elegant medium bodied red wain.
